EMERGENCY SERVICES MILLAGE BALLOT PROPOSAL

At a special meeting of the Middlebury Township Board called to order by Supervisor Anthony Sinicropi on May 25, 2006 at 5:00 p.m. at the Middlebury Township Hall located at 7627 West M-21, Ovid, Michigan 48866, the following resolution was offered:

Moved by *Stevens* and seconded by *Dutton* that the following proposal be served on the Shiawassee County Clerk to be placed on the August 8, 2006 General Primary Election ballot:

**MIDDLEBURY TOWNSHIP, SHIAWASSEE COUNTY
EMERGENCY SERVICES (FIRE & AMBULANCE) PROPOSAL**

This proposal renews the Emergency Services Millage that expired December 31, 2005, and restores the millage for all purposes authorized by law for emergency services.

Shall the tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Middlebury Township imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution be renewed for said Township at 2.25 mills (\$2.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for the period of four years starting 2006 through 2009 for all purposes authorized by law for emergency services; and shall the Township levy such millage for said purpose, thereby raising in the first year an estimated \$86,464.00?
