

**MIDDLEBURY TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION 2006-07**  
**AMENDMENT TO MIDDLEBURY CEMETERY RULES**

At a regular meeting of the Middlebury Township Board called to order by Supervisor Anthony Sinicropi on July 13, 2006 at 7:00 p.m. at the Ovid, Municipal Building at 114 East Front Street Ovid, Michigan 48866, the following resolution was offered:

WHEREAS, Middlebury Cemetery has a history of identifying individual graves by using directional descriptions,

WHEREAS, the potential to create errors in describing the location of a particular grave is greater with this system, in writing or verbally,

WHEREAS, the use of numbering the graves in a methodical manner would alleviate the potential of making errors,

WHEREAS, the Middlebury Township Board has purchased a computer software program that effectively accommodates the use of numbered graves,

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED, that from this day forward, any given grave, in any given lot located in the Middlebury Township Cemetery shall be identified by a number as described in the Middlebury Township Cemetery Rules under Section I, K. The use of directions as a written descriptive method to locate any given grave will be done away with.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Board Member Audrey Sovis and supported by Board Member Paul Dutton

Upon roll call vote, the following voted "Aye": Stevens, Sovis, Sinicropi, Simpson, and Dutton.

There were no "Nay" votes. There were no board members absent.

The Supervisor declared the resolution adopted.
