BOARD POLICY REGARDING LETTERS PUBLISHED BY BOARD MEMBERS

WHEREAS, clarification is needed in regard to any letter that may be published by a board member and is signed as such,

WHEREAS, the public's perception may not embrace the correct intent of a letter that is signed by a board member and contains opinions;

WHEREAS, a published letter may not necessarily reflect the opinions of all board members,

WHEREAS, each board member should have the right to read any letter that could be published that may be perceived as the entire Board's opinion,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that any communication drafted by a board member who signs their name and board position at the bottom, must first get approval from the entire board before they may have it published.
