Road Millage Proposal on the August and/or November election ballot

WHEREAS, the Shiawassee County is not providing money to repair and maintain roads in Middlebury township.

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of Middlebury Township to provide funding for the repair and maintenance of roads within Middlebury Township; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. That the following proposal for a road millage shall be placed upon a ballot for the August Ballot:

Authorize collection of two (2) mills for four (4) years commencing in 2008 until 2011 for the maintenance, repair and improvement of the existing roadways only, within Middlebury Township. If this proposal passes, the Township expects to collect \$80,000 in first year.

Motion was made by Simpson, and supported by Dutton, to adopt the foregoing resolution.
