

**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT
EMERGENCY SERVICES MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

Middlebury Township, Shiawassee County

Resolution Number 2008-06

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Middlebury Township wishes to renew the millage for emergency services that is scheduled to expire in 2010; and

WHEREAS, townships may provide emergency services, as authorized by MCL 41.801, et seq, and other applicable statutes; and

WHEREAS, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the electors of Middlebury Township previously authorized 2.25 mills to be levied for emergency services; and

WHEREAS, the previously-authorized millage for emergency services has been reduced by the required millage rollbacks; and

WHEREAS, the previously-authorized millage for emergency services will expire in 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Middlebury Township wishes to renew the previously-authorized millage for emergency services for an additional fourteen (14) years, 2010 through 2023 inclusive, at a base rate of 2.25 mills, which rate will be reduced by required rollbacks unless such rollbacks are overridden by a vote of the electorate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Middlebury Township, Shiawassee County, approves the following millage renewal question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August, 2008, election ballot:

EMERGENCY SERVICES MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall the previous voted increase in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Middlebury Township, of 2.25 mills (\$2.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value), which has been reduced by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at 2.25 mills (\$2.25 per \$1,000 of taxable value), as presently reduced by the required millage rollbacks, and levied for fourteen (14) years, beginning in 2010 and through 2023 inclusive, for all purposes authorized by law for emergency services, raising an estimated \$94,361.48 in 2010.
