

**Middlebury Township
Resolution 2022-12
Rescinding RESOLUTION 2006-11**

This resolution rescinds Resolution 2006-11 and any other preceding or prior resolutions that pertain to the fees for land splits within Middlebury Township.

WHEREAS, property owners or realtors often wait for regular meeting dates to have land split contracts signed by the board,

WHEREAS, with deadlines, land splits sometimes need to be signed in a timely manner,

WHEREAS, a signature is needed in order for the split to become finalized,

WHEREAS, reviewing and studying the proposed land split can take considerable time and effort,

WHEREAS, the Assessor is contracted by the township to assess and sign off land splits, AND

WHEREAS, The Assessor sets the fee rate for assessing and land split fees within its contract with the township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Middlebury Township board, gives authority to the Assessor to sign off on county approved land splits. When a split is requested, the current contracted fee will be collected, payable to Middlebury Township and will then be paid to the Assessor contracted to sign the split.
