

**RESOLUTION TO ADOPT EMERGENCY SERVICES
MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL**

Middlebury Township, Shiawassee County

Resolution Number 2026- 02

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Middlebury Township wishes to renew the millage for emergency services that is scheduled to expire in 2025; and

WHEREAS, townships may provide emergency services, as authorized by MCL 41.801, et seq, and other applicable statutes; and

WHEREAS, townships may impose and levy ad valorem property taxes to finance lawful public services, as authorized by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and other laws; and

WHEREAS, the electors of Middlebury Township previously authorized 3.00 mills to be levied for emergency services in the form of one millage authorized at 2.25 mills and a second, supplemental millage authorized at 0.75 mills; and

WHEREAS, the previously-authorized millages for emergency services have been reduced by the required millage rollbacks; and

WHEREAS, the previously-authorized millages for emergency services will expire in 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board of Middlebury Township wishes to consolidate and renew the previously-authorized millages for emergency services for a new five-year period, 2026 through 2030 inclusive, at the consolidated base rate of 3.00 mills, which rate will be reduced by required rollbacks unless such rollbacks are overridden by a vote of the electorate;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Board of Middlebury Township, Shiawassee County, approves the following millage renewal question language and directs the Clerk to submit it to be placed on the August, 2026, election ballot:

EMERGENCY SERVICES MILLAGE RENEWAL

Shall Middlebury Township continue to levy three mills (\$3.00 per \$1,000.00) on taxable value of property located in the Township of Middlebury, Shiawassee County, Michigan, for five years beginning with the 2026 tax levy year and running through the 2030 tax levy year (inclusive), which will raise in the first year of such levy and estimated revenue of \$179,697 to be to be used exclusively for all purposes authorized by law for emergency services including a fire department, rescue services, and ambulance service? If approved, this millage will be a consolidation and renewal of two previously authorized millages.
